WHAT IS I-PORTUNUS?

i-Portunus is an initiative funded by the **European Union**, to help artists and culture professionals take advantage of short-term and flexible cross-border opportunities: to move between European countries, develop international collaborations and audiences, and fully benefit from – and contribute to – Europe's diverse cultural ecosystems.

The results of this pilot project will be key in shaping a new mobility support action in the **Creative Europe** programme, 2021-2027.



WHAT IS I-PORTUNUS?

FOCUS DISCIPLINES

The focus is limited to two sectors:

Performing Arts (*Circus, Dance, Opera, Performance, Puppetry, Street Art, Theatre*)

Visual Arts (*Crafts, Design, Digital arts, Fashion, Fine arts, Graphic arts, Photography*).

TYPES OF MOBILITY

- International Collaborations
- Production-oriented residencies
- Professional development

MOBILITY

For i-Portunus, **mobility** means a trip abroad for professional purposes. It might be travelling to a professional artist residency, to present your work for international audiences, to exhibition or showcase, to work with cultural project partners, to develop international collaborations etc.

LENGTH OF MOBILITY

A mobility must be **between 15 and 60 days** in length.

LEVELS OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

15 to 29 days: **1500 Euro**

30 to 60 days: **2400 Euro**

WHAT IS I-PORTUNUS?

PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

Applicants must be legal residents of a [Creative Europe](#) member state. Mobilities have to take place in a [Creative Europe](#) member state, other than the one where the applicant is a legal resident.

Creative Europe member states:

Albania, Armenia, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia And Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Kosovo, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova, Montenegro, The Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Tunisia, Ukraine and The United Kingdom.*

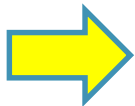
This includes their overseas countries and territories:

Greenland, New Caledonia And Dependencies, French Polynesia, French Southern And Antarctic Territories, Wallis And Futuna Islands, Saint Pierre And Miquelon, Saint-Barthélemy, Aruba, Netherlands Antilles (Bonaire, Curaçao, Saba, Sint Eustatius, Sint Maarten), Anguilla, Cayman Islands, Falkland Islands, South Georgia And The South Sandwich Islands, Montserrat, Pitcairn, Saint Helena And Dependencies, British Antarctic Territory, British Indian Ocean Territory, Turks And Caicos Islands, British Virgin Islands, Bermuda.

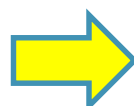

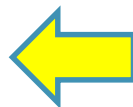

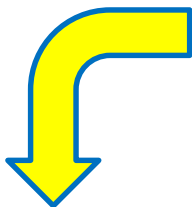


For group applications:

- 1 person submits application for whole group
- 1 CV and portfolio for whole group
 - *CV and portfolio should reflect whole group*
- See *Group Applications* page for detailed informations

- Portfolio (Max. 10 Pages)
- Proof of Preparation (Invitation Letter etc.)
- Signed Declaration on Honour

GROUP APPLICATIONS

DEFINITION OF A GROUP

A fixed number of **up to 5 people**, having the same coherent mobility. Members can come from different countries but have to go to the same destination, arriving and leaving on the same date. The mobility must focus on **one single group project**.

FINANCE

A separate contract will be signed with each group member. Each member will receive an **equal full amount of mobility support**, paid to their personal bank account. Mobility support cannot be paid to a company/organization bank account. Mobility support will only be paid to individuals.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

One person submits the application for the whole group. The group has to **submit 1 collective CV and 1 collective portfolio**. These should reflect the work of the group.

TRAVEL AND HOST ORGANIZATION

Group members who are staying within their country of residence will not receive mobility support, however members of the group who do travel to another country will receive mobility support. A member of the group cannot act as a host. The whole group has to be **hosted by a professional organization**.

WHAT'S NEW IN THE THIRD CALL?

MOBILITY CATEGORIES

The third call only has two duration categories:

- **15 to 29 days:** 1500 Euro
- **30 to 60 days:** 2400 Euro

Segmented Mobility

In the first Call, all mobilities had to be continuous, meaning it was not possible to split the mobility into different parts. In the third call, applicants can opt for a segmented mobility. Each single trip in a segmented mobility must last a minimum of 5 days. The total number of days has to be between 15 and 60 days. *Example: 10 Days in November and 8 days in December*

Disability Support

Additional financial support can be provided to artists and cultural professionals living with disabilities.

WHAT HAPPENED DURING THE SECOND CALL?

i-Portunus received 710 applications during the second call. Considering group applications, this brings the number of individuals to 1141.

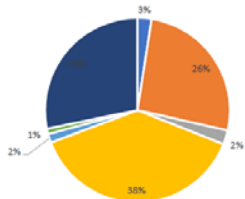

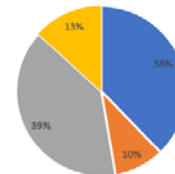

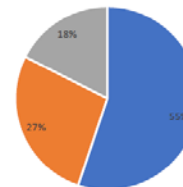
